### 2013 SCRMC TRIALS

For 2013 the Club Trials Championship will be run over eight rounds with the best six scores to count towards the Club Championship. This year the club has decided not to run a round of the Scottish Support Championship after the trouble at last year's round at Abington.

This year the Closed to Club trials will continue to follow the format started in 2011 where the events will be run over 2 routes, the normal B Route and the W Route. This route is more suitable for beginners, both Adults and Youths, novices and riders on more standard Pre '65 and Twin Shock bikes. The B Route is to be kept as it is at present as regards to the level of severity. The B route will continue to be marked with the traditional red and blue markers while the new route will be marked with double white markers. Hopefully this will continue to tempt more of the older bikes out at the events. Also there is a new class being introduced for Aircooled Mono's such as TY Yamahas.

With the Dunoon scramble being so close to the Pre '65 Scottish and the SSDT, unfortunately it is very unlikely that the manpower will be available to lay out a trial on the Saturday.
